The Imhoff Art Collection

The Richard Larsen Museum



The Richard Larsen Museum presents the unique history and artifacts of the Barr Colonists. These settlers from the British Isles homesteaded the Lloydminster region in 1903. Artifacts include agricultural equipment, furniture and household items. In addition to the museum displays, visit Lloydminster's first church, a schoolhouse dating from 1906, a furnished log cabin and an old filling station.
